Ambassador of the United Mexican States pays courtesy visit to the deputy speaker

Carlos Eugenio Garcia de Alba Zepeda, Ambassador of the United Mexican States, who resides in Rome, paid a courtesy visit to the Deputy Speaker Claudette Buttigieg.

Deputy Speaker Buttigieg welcomed the new Mexican ambassador and mentioned the excellent relations that exist between Malta and Mexico since their establishment in October 1975.

The deputy speaker and the Mexican ambassador discussed parliamentary issues, particularly the setting up of a joint parliamentary friendship group. They noted that a small community of Mexicans lived in Malta whereas there were also a number of Maltese living in Mexico, one of whom has even opened a traditional Maltese bakery in the town of Coyoacàn.

The two dignitaries referred to the trade and commercial relations and the importance of enhancing these relations in various fields, including agriculture, machinery, financial services and transshipment.

The relations between the EU and Mexico as well as migration also featured in the discussion.
