Ambassador of Romania pays courtesy visit to Speaker Farrugia

Ambassador of the Republic of Romania Gabriela Dancau paid a courtesy visit to Speaker of the House of Representatives Anġlu Farrugia.

The Speaker recalled his visit to Bucharest in 2013 and the reciprocal visit of his Romanian counterpart to Malta in 2015 and confirmed that the exchange of visits reflects the long-standing and cordial bilateral relations that exist between Malta and Romania. Being members of the European Union, gives both countries the opportunity to work together with other European partners to address global and regional challenges.

Anġlu Farrugia also referred to the signing of the agreement of cooperation in the areas of education, science and culture as well as the ongoing talks between respective academic institutions aimed at the sharing of experience and providing an educational opportunity to students to enhance their knowledge and expertise.

During their discussion, the Speaker and Ambassador Dancau referred to the cultural activities organised by Romania in Malta and trade and commercial matters and Malta's tenure on the United Nations Security Council for the period 2023-2024. Both dignitaries recognised that whilst the commercial relationship between Malta and Romania is good, there is always room for further improvement. The connectivity provided by several airlines can create a window of opportunity and a valuable tool to increase the tourist traffic between both countries.

The ambassador was accompanied by Eugen Rosca, Minister Counsellor at the Romanian Embassy in Rome.
