IL-PRESIDENT, bil-parir u l-kunsens tal-Kamra tad-Deputati, imlaqqgħa f'dan il-Parlament, u bl-awtorità ta' l-istess, hareġ b'liġi dan li ġej:—

1. (1) Dan l-Att jista' jissejjah l-Att ta' l-1986 li jemenda l-Att dwar il-Liċenzi tal-Pulizija, u għandu jinqara u jiftiehem haġa waħda ma' l-Att ta' l-1949 dwar il-Liċenzi tal-Pulizija, hawnhekk iżjed "il quddiem imsejjah "l-Att prinċipali".

2. Minnufih wara l-artikolu 3 ta' l-Att prinċipali għandu jiżdied l-artikolu ġdid li ġej:

4. Meta taht xi regolament magħmul bis-saħħa ta' l-artikolu 3 ta' dan l-Att liċenza biex tinsaq vettura bil-mutur tinhareġ jew tiġġedded għal żmien ta' iktar minn sena kalendarja, u matul iż-żmien li għalih dik il-liċenza tkun inharġet jew iġġeddet, id-dritt li jithallas għall-hruġ jew għat-tiġdid ta' dik il-liċenza jiżdied, f'dak il-każ, minkejja l-hlas ta' xi dritt fiż-żmien tal-hruġ jew tat-tiġdid ta' dik il-liċenza, għandha tithallas lill-Kummissarju tal-Pulizija d-differenza bejn l-ammont imhallas mal-hruġ jew mat-tiġdid tal-liċenza u r-rata l-ġdida tad-dritt li għandu jithallas, u kemm-il darba dik id-differenza ma tithallasx dik il-liċenza ma titqiesx li ġiet imġedda."

Għanijiet u Raġunijiet

L-Għan ta' l-Abbozz huwa li jipprovdi għall-hlas ta' kull zieda ta' drittijiet ta' liċenza tas-sewqan kull meta dawk id-drittijiet ikunu thallsu bil-quddiem għal iktar minn sena kalendarja waħda u wara jiżdiedu.

A BILL**entitled**

AN ACT further to amend the Police Licences Act, 1949.

BE IT ENACTED by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and commencement.
Act XXXIV of 1949

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Police Licences (Amendment) Act, 1986, and shall be read and construed as one with the Police Licences Act, 1949, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January, 1986.

Addition of new section to the principal Act.

2. Immediately after section 3 of the principal Act there shall be added the following new section:

"Additional fee due in certain cases.

4. Where under any regulation made in virtue of section 3 of this Act a licence to drive a motor vehicle is issued or renewed for a period of more than one calendar year, and during the period for which such licence has been issued or renewed, the fee payable for the issue or renewal of such licence is increased, then, notwithstanding the payment of any fee at the time of the issue or renewal of such licence, there shall be paid to the Commissioner of Police the difference between the amount paid on the issue or renewal of the licence and the new rate of fee payable, and unless that difference is paid such licence shall be deemed not to be renewed."

Objects and Reasons

The purpose of the Bill is to provide for the payment of any increase of driving licence fees wherever such fees have been paid in advance for more than one calendar year and subsequently increased.
