A BILL**entitled**

An Act further to amend the Education Act, 1974.

BE IT ENACTED by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Education (Amendment) Act, 1987, and shall be read and construed as one with the Education Act, 1974, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act". Short title.

2. In the Maltese text of subsection (5) of section 39 of the principal Act, immediately after the words "bħala haddjema, studenti numru" there shall be inserted the words "ta' persuni b'żieda ma' dawk l-impjegati". Amendment of
section 39 of the
principal Act.
3. Immediately after section 39 of the principal law there shall be added the following new section: Addition of
new section
39A to the
principal Act.
- 39A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act worker-students who are nominated by their employer and who on the 15th February of the year in which they are to be admitted to the University are over twenty-five years of age and have been in continuous, full-time employment with the employer nominating them for a period of at least not less than one year, and on the basis of such other requirements, including age and grade as the employer may determine, and only in such cases shall preference be given in the selection by the Selection Board."
- "Preference given to nominated worker students"

Application.

4. This Act shall apply to the selection of students for entry in the University after the 1st day of January, 1987.

Objects and Reasons

The object of the Bill is to give equal opportunity for entry into the University to all worker-students except for worker-students over twenty-five years of age nominated by their employers,
