The Ambassador of Kosovo calls on the Deputy Speaker

The Ambassador of Kosovo, Lendita Haxitaxhim, called on the Deputy Speaker of the House of Representatives, David Agius.

The Deputy Speaker reiterated that Malta highly values the excellent relations between Malta and Kosovo and expressed the wish that these relations continue to be strengthened. He also referred to Malta's long-standing policy to support EU enlargement and confirmed its support for Kosovo's journey towards full membership.

Deputy Speaker Agius noted the visit to Malta of a trade mission from Kosovo and augured that the discussions held with Maltese institutions will serve as a catalyst to improve trade relations between both countries.

The Ambassador welcomed the comments made by the Deputy Speaker and assured her engagement to work towards the enhancement of relations between Malta and Kosovo. She also encouraged increased exchanges in the fields of education, culture, and the training of diplomats. The Deputy Speaker agreed with the ambassador on such exchanges, and he was also of the same opinion as that expressed by the ambassador about establishing the Parliamentary Friends Group between Malta and Kosovo. Such initiatives will further enhance the relationship between the two countries.

The Ambassador also outlined the major features of Kosovo's foreign policies, particularly regarding the country's journey to become a full member of the EU and the neighbourly relations in the Balkan region.
