1. (1) Dan l-Att jista' jissejjah l-Att ta' l-1980 li jemenda l-Ordinanza dwar ir-Regulament tat-Traffiku (Emenda Nru. 2) u għandu jinqara u jftiehem haġa waħda ma' l-Ordinanza dwar ir-Regulament tat-Traffiku, hawnhekk iżjed 'il quddiem imsejha "il-liġi prinċipali".

(2) Dan l-Att għandu jibda jsehh erbatax-il jum wara li jsir liġi.

2. L-artikolu 17 tal-liġi prinċipali għandu jiġi emendat kif ġej:

(a) fis-subartikolu (1) tiegħu, minflok il-kliem "żewġ liri" għandhom jidhlu l-kliem "hames liri";

(b) minflok il-proviso għas-subartikolu (1) tiegħu għandu jidhol dan li ġej:

"Izda, fil-każ ta' reat muri fl-ewwel kolonna ta' l-Ewwel Skeda li tinsab ma' din l-Ordinanza, il-piena li għandha tingħata għandha tkun dik murija fit-tieni kolonna tagħha u, fil-każ ta' reat muri fl-ewwel kolonna tat-Tieni Skeda li tinsab ma' din l-Ordinanza, il-piena li għandha tingħata m'għandha f'ebda każ tkun inqas mill-ammenda relattiva murija fit-tieni kolonna tagħha."; u

(ċ) is-subartikolu (3) tiegħu għandu jiġi emendat kif ġej:

(i) minflok il-kliem "ta' l-Iskeda" għandhom jidhlu l-kliem "tat-Tieni Skeda"; u

(ii) minnufih fit-tarf tiegħu għandu jiżdied il-proviso li ġej:

"Izda fil-każ ta' karrozza *self drive* is-sid tagħha jkun

responsabbli għar-reat kemm-il darba l-multa relattiva ma tkunx tħallset.”

Għanijiet u Raġunijiet

L-Għan ta' dan l-Abbozz huwa li jiżiedu ċerti pieni għall-ksur ta' disposizzjonijiet li għandhom x'jaqsmu mat-traffiku u sabiex is-sistema ta' *tickets* għal reati tat-traffiku tkun tista' tapplika għal aktar każijiet.

A BILL**entitled**

AN ACT further to amend the Traffic Regulation Ordinance, Cap. 105.

BE IT ENACTED by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Traffic Regulation (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1980, and shall be read and construed as one with the Traffic Regulation Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as “the principal law”.

Short title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall come into force fourteen days after its enactment.

2. Section 17 of the principal law shall be amended as follows:

Amendment of section 17 of the principal law.

(a) in subsection (1) thereof, for the words “two pounds” there shall be substituted the words “five pounds”;

(b) for the proviso to subsection (1) thereof there shall be substituted the following:

“Provided that, in the case of an offence set out in the first column of the First Schedule to this Ordinance, the punishment awardable shall be that shown in the second column thereof and, in the case of an offence set out in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance, the punishment awardable shall in no case be less than the relative fine shown in the second column thereof.”; and

(c) subsection (3) thereof shall be amended as follows:

(i) for the words “of the Schedule” there shall be substituted the words “of the Second Schedule”; and

(ii) immediately at the end thereof there shall be added the following proviso:

"Provided that in the case of a self-drive car the owner thereof shall be responsible for the offence unless the relative fine has been paid."

Amendment of section 21 of the principal law.

3. Section 21 of the principal law shall be amended as follows:
- (a) for the words "of the Schedule" in subsection (1) thereof, there shall be substituted the words "of the Second Schedule", and
- (b) for the words "five pounds" in subsection (6) thereof there shall be substituted the words "twenty pounds".

Substitution of the Schedule to the principal law.

4. For the Schedule to the principal law there shall be substituted the following Schedules:

Objects and Reasons

The Object of this Bill is to increase certain penalties for contravening the provisions relative to motor traffic and to provide for increased applicability of the traffic offence ticket system.
