### ***Courtesy visit by Ervin Ibrahimovic, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign and European Affairs of Montenegro, on Speaker of the House of Representatives, Anġlu Farrugia***

Dr Anġlu Farrugia, Speaker of the House of Representatives, welcomed Ervin Ibrahimovic, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign and European Affairs of Montenegro, for a courtesy visit at the Parliament today.
