### ***Speaker of the House of Representatives hosts Delegation from the UK's National Liberal Club Commonwealth Forum***

Anġlu Farrugia, Speaker of the House of Representatives of Malta, today welcomed a distinguished delegation from the United Kingdom's National Liberal Club (NLC) Commonwealth Forum.
