Speaker of the House of Representatives Anġlu Farrugia, received the Speaker of the National Assembly of Hungary László Kövér, at the Parliament of Malta for a bilateral meeting held as part of an official visit by a Hungarian parliamentary delegation to Malta from 28 to 30 May 2025.

During the meeting, the two dignitaries held in-depth discussions on issues of mutual interest. They highlighted the strong and longstanding relations between Malta and Hungary and expressed a shared commitment to further enhancing bilateral cooperation, particularly at the parliamentary level.

The discussions also covered regional and European Union matters, where both parties acknowledged the importance of close collaboration among EU Member States, especially in addressing common challenges such as migration, security, and economic development.
