Speaker of the House of Representatives to participate in the Conference of Speakers of the European Union Parliaments in Copenhagen

The Speaker of the House of Representatives, Anglu Farrugia, departed Malta this afternoon to attend and participate in the Conference of Speakers of the European Union Parliaments, known as the EUSC, which will be held in Copenhagen, Denmark, from 3rd to 5th May 2026.

The Conference, hosted by the Danish Parliament, will bring together Speakers and representatives of national parliaments of EU Member States, together with representatives of the European Parliament and invited parliamentary delegations.

During the Conference, Speaker Farrugia is expected to address those present and participate in discussions on the role of parliaments in a changing European and international environment. The programme includes sessions on Europe in a Changing World Order, Democratic Resilience in Times of Change, and Ensuring Continuity and Security in Times of Hybrid Threats.

The Conference will also provide an opportunity for parliamentary leaders to exchange views on security, enlargement, democratic accountability, institutional resilience, disinformation, hybrid threats, and the continued strengthening of interparliamentary cooperation across Europe.

Speaker Farrugia will be accompanied by the Clerk of the House of Representatives, Ms Eleanor Scerri.
