TINNOTA l-impenn u l-qbil ġenerali tal-Kamra dwar il-htieġa li teżisti sabiex ix-xogħol tal-Kamra jitjieb kemm fil-livell u fl-effettività tiegħu u li għal dan il-għan, fost affarijiet oħra, hemm bżonn li jissahħu d-dispożizzjonijiet tal-Ordni Permanenti dwar il-partecipazzjoni tal-Membri fil-Kamra u dwar il-kontabilità lejn il-pubbliku; u

TIRRIŻOLVI li l-Ordni Permanenti tal-Kamra tad-Deputati, fil-verżjoni bil-Malti u fil-verżjoni bl-Ingliż, għandhom jiġu emendati kif ġej:

Emendi fit-test Malti

1. L-Ordni Permanenti 158 għandu jiġi sostitwit b'dan li ġej:

Membri bil-permess ta' assenza

158. Membru jiġi skużat mis-servizz tal-Kamra jew minn fuq kull kumitat tagħha sakemm ikollu permess ta' assenza mill-iSpeaker.

Dawk il-Membri li jkunu fuq xogħol tal-Kamra, tal-Grupp Parlamentari jew fuq xogħol uffiċjali tal-partit, u Ministri u Segretarji Parlamentari li jkunu fuq xogħol tal-Gvern, u Membri Parlamentari li jakkumpanjaw Ministru jew Segretarju Parlamentari fuq xogħol tal-Gvern barra minn Malta, ikunu mnizzla fil-minuti tal-Kamra li huma skużati. Tkun ir-responsabbiltà tal-Whips li jieħdu ħsieb jinfurmaw lill-iSpeaker b'dawk il-Membri li għandhom ikunu mnizzla bhala skużati u għal liema raġuni.

Fil-minuti għandha tinzamm distinzjoni bejn Membri li jkunu msiefra fuq xogħol tal-Parlament, tal-Gvern, tal-Grupp Parlamentari jew dak uffiċjali tal-partit.

Dawk il-Membri li jkunu morda jew ikunu sugġetti għal xi ċirkustanza straordinarja jkunu mnizzla fil-minuti tal-Kamra bhala skużati u dan wara li jkunu pprezentaw evidenza li tkun giet approvata bhala tali mill-iSpeaker.

2. L-Ordni Permenenti 159 għandu jiġi sostitwit b'dan li ġej:

Membri assenti bla permess

(1) Jekk Membru jkun assenti matul ġurnata parlamentari shiha mingħajr permess ta' assenza, jehel penali amministrattiva. L-ammont tal-penali għandu jkun ta' hamsin ewro (€50) u għandu japplika għal Membri Parlamentari kollha inkluż Ministri u Segretarji Parlamentari.

(2) Il-penali amministrattivi dovuti għandhom jithallsu lill-Iskrivan tal-Kamra li jista' wkoll

jesigihom bhala dejn civili.

Ghall-fini ta' dan l-Ordni Permanenti "gurnata parlamentari" tfisser gurnata li fiha jsir xoghol parlamentari li jikkonsisti f'seduta wahda jew izjed tal-Kamra u tal-Kumitati Parlamentari."

Emendi fit-test Ingliz

1. Standing Order 158 shall be substituted by the following:

Members on leave of absence

"158. A member shall be excused from service in the House or on any committee thereof so long as he has leave of absence from the Speaker.

Members who are on business related to the House, the Parliamentary Group or on official party business, and Ministers and Parliamentary Secretaries on Government business and Members of Parliament who accompany a Minister or a Parliamentary Secretary on Government business, outside Malta shall be entered in the minutes of the House as being excused. It shall be the responsibility of the Whips to ensure that they inform the Speaker of those Members who are to be considered excused and for what reason.

The Minutes shall distinguish between Members who are abroad on Parliamentary, Government, Parliamentary Group or official party business.

Members who are sick or are subject to an extraordinary circumstance shall be entered in the minutes of the House as excused, after producing evidence which will have been approved as such by the Speaker.

2. Standing Order 159 shall be substituted by the following:

Members absent without leave

(1) If a Member is absent during the whole of a parliamentary day without leave of absence, he shall be liable to an administrative penalty. The administrative penalty shall amount to fifty euro (€50) and shall apply to all Members of Parliament, including Ministers and Parliamentary Secretaries.

(2) The administrative penalty due shall be paid to the Clerk of the House who may also demand it as a civil debt.

For the purposes of this Standing Order "parliamentary day" means a day during which parliamentary work is carried out and which consists of a sitting or more of the House and of Parliamentary Committees."
