**PRODUCT SAFETY ACT
(CAP. 427)**

Construction Products (Implementation) Regulations, 2011

IN exercise of the powers conferred by articles 38 and 39 of the Product Safety Act, the Prime Minister, on the advice of the Malta Competition and Consumer Affairs Authority, has made the following regulations:-

1. (1) The title of these regulations is the Construction Products (Implementation) Regulations, 2011. Citation and scope.

(2) These regulations implement the provisions of Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2011 laying down harmonised conditions for the marketing of construction products and repealing Council Directive 89/106/EEC.

2. For the purposes of these regulations, the following definition shall apply: Definitions.

the “Technical Regulations Division” means the Technical Regulations Division within the Malta Competition and Consumer Affairs Authority as established by the Malta Competition and Consumer Affairs Authority Act, 2011. Cap. 510.

3. The designated Product Contact Point for Construction within the meaning of Article 10 of Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011 shall be the same Product Contact Point designated by the Product Contact Point (Designation) Regulations, 2009. Establishment of the Product Contact Point for Construction. L.N. 191 of 2009.

4. The competent national authority within the meaning of Articles 11(7), 11(8), 12(2), 13(7), 13(9), 14(4) and 14(5) of Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011 shall be the Technical Regulations Division. Establishment of the competent authority.

5. (1) For the purposes of designation and notification under Chapters V and VII of Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011, conformity assessment bodies shall, in addition to the requirements Designation of conformity assessment bodies. L.N. 136 of 2003.

set out in Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011, meet the requirements laid down in the Method for Designating Conformity Assessment Bodies Regulations, 2003.

(2) The designating authority within the meaning of Chapter V and the notifying authority within the meaning of Chapter VII of Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011 shall be the Technical Regulations Division.

Establishment of the market surveillance authority.

6. The market surveillance authority within the meaning of Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011 shall be the Technical Regulations Division.

Languages provisions.

7. The information and documentation specified in Articles 7(4), 11(6), 11(8), 13(4), 13(9), 14(2) and 14(5) of Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011 shall be supplied in at least the Maltese or the English language.

Penalties.
Cap. 427.

8. The penalties and proceedings applicable for the infringement of any of the provisions of Chapter III of Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011 shall be those provided for in Part IV of the Product Safety Act.

Revokes L.N. 270 OF 2001

9. The Construction Products Regulations, 2001 and its amendments shall be revoked as from the 1st July 2013.

Saving.

10. As from the 1st July 2013, references to the revoked regulations shall be construed as references to Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011 as implemented by these regulations.
