

MEETING BETWEEN A MALTESE PARLIAMENTARY DELEGATION AND A DELEGATION FROM THE HUNGARIAN PARLIAMENT'S CONSTITUTIONAL, JUSTICE AND HOUSE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Today, a delegation from the Hungarian Parliament's Constitutional, Justice and House Affairs Committee formed by Dr Miklós Hanko Farago, Deputy Chairman of the Committee, Dr Károly Kontrat, Member of the Committee, Dr Anett Borbely, General Advisor to the Committee and the Ambassador of Hungary in Italy, Dr Miklós Merényi had a meeting with a Maltese Parliamentary Delegation headed by the Hon. David Agius and which also included the Hon. Frans Agius, the Hon. Charlò Bonnici, the Hon. Censu Galea and the Hon. Owen Bonnici.

The two sides exchanged their views on various aspects. However, the discussion mainly focused on Parliamentary Procedures for the enactment of Legislative Acts and the duration of laws to be enacted, the work of Parliamentary Committees, the newly formed Select Committee and its work, and the election of Mr Speaker.
