SPEAKER ATTENDS THE PARLIAMENTARY FORUM ON INTELLIGENCE - SECURITY IN VIENNA

On Wednesday 6th May, Speaker of the House of Representatives, Parliament of Malta Anglu Farrugia, attended the Parliamentary Forum on Intelligence - Security, organised in Holfburg, Vienna.

During the first day of the conference presentations were given by the Chairman of the Privacy and Civil Liberties Oversight Board, Mr David Medine and board member Rachel Brand, followed by a speech by Professor Gerhart Holzinger, President of the Austrian Constitutional Court. The conference was concluded with a presentation by Giovanni Buttarelli, who was recently appointed European Data Protection Supervisor.
