SPEAKER PARTICIPATES IN THE VIENNA PARLIAMENTARY FORUM ON INTELLIGENCE - SECURITY

The Speaker of the House of Representatives, Parliament of Malta, Dr Anġlu Farrugia has intervened during the parliamentary forum on Intelligence - Security being organised in the Hofburg, Vienna.

In his speech, he focused on the model of intelligence oversight for EU Nations in order to ensure the basic human rights in the targeting and retention of stored data by EU States.

Speaker Anġlu Farrugia emphasised the importance of a strong EU approach together with the U.S. Government to deal with the human traffickers in Libya as part of the solution to the future stability of Libya.

Following Speaker Farrugia's speech, the Conference was addressed by the Chairman of the House Intelligence Committee of the U.S. Congress, Hon. Devin Nunes.

The Speaker is leading a delegation which is composed of Government Whip Hon. Godfrey Farrugia MP and Opposition Member Hon. Chris Said MP.
