**PUBLIC TRANSPORT AUTHORITY ACT
(CAP. 332)**

Gozo Mail and Passenger Service (Fares) Regulations, 1997

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 27 of the Public Transport Authority Act, the Public Transport Authority, with the consent of the Minister for Transport and Ports and with the concurrence of the Minister for Economic Affairs and Finance, has made the following regulations:-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Gozo Mail and Passenger Service (Fares) Regulations, 1997, and shall come into force on the 3rd February, 1997. Citation and commencement.

2. The fares payable by passengers and vehicles for the journey from Cirkewwa or Sa Maison, Malta to Gozo, or vice-versa, shall be those shown in the First Schedule to these regulations. Passenger and vehicle fares.

3. The fares payable on commercial and/or other vehicles falling within the parameters given in the Second Schedule to these regulations for the journey from Cirkewwa or Sa Maison, Malta to Gozo, or vice-versa, shall be those shown in the said Schedule. Commercial vehicle fares.

4. For the purposes of these regulations, a Commuter may be requested to produce his identity card or any other identity document at the time of the issuing of the ticket or at any other time of boarding the vessel or of the trip so as to establish his identity as a Gozo resident. Identity of Gozo resident.

5. Loads on commercial vehicles are not to exceed the registered capacity of the vehicle and/or an axle-weight in excess of 13 tons. Commercial loads.

6. The Gozo Mail and Passenger Service (Fares) Regulations, 1981, are hereby revoked. Revokes L.N. 30 of 1981.

FIRST SCHEDULE

(Regulation 2)

Fares	Tariffs on return trip basis
<p>1. Passenger Standard Fare This fare applies for all passengers travelling on Company ferries.</p>	Lm1.75
<p>2. Gozo Resident Passenger Subsidized Fare This fare is only applicable to Gozitan permanent residents.</p>	Lm0.75
<p>3. Senior Citizen Subsidized Fare This fare is applicable to all citizens holders of the 'Karta Anzjan'.</p>	Lm0.50
<p>4. Children's Fare This fare is applicable to all children from the age of 3 up to 12 years.</p>	Lm0.50
<p>5. Frequent Passenger Fare This is a special fare for all passengers without distinction of residence who commute frequently during any seven days. This ticket shall be valid for seven days only and the holder shall be entitled to travel five times with this ticket. The identity document required for this ticket is a valid Identity Card or Passport whose number shall be printed on each portion of the ticket. These tickets shall only be valid if shown with the supporting identity document which was presented at the time of purchase and whose number is stamped thereon. These tickets are not transferable and must be used during the seven day validity period.</p>	Lm2.50
<p>6. Car and Driver Standard Fare This fare is applicable to all commuters without distinction.</p>	Lm5.75
<p>7. Car and Gozitan Resident Driver Standard Fare The basic fare of the car is the same as for all other commuters while the price difference is in the Gozo resident passenger subsidized fare.</p>	Lm4.75

| 8. | Car and Driver Frequent Passenger Fare
The criteria for purchase of this ticket is the same as for the Frequent Passenger Fare, but the registration number of the vehicle shall be also printed on each portion of the ticket, and only the vehicle so registered shall travel with this ticket. | Lm15.00 |

| 10. | Motor cycle and Gozo Resident Driver Fare

1.	Length overall including overhanging cargo exceeding 4.70m and not exceeding 5.70m, and/or width exceeding 1.70m but not exceeding 1.85m	Lm7.00
2.	Length overall including overhanging cargo exceeding 5.7m and not exceeding 6.5m, and/or width exceeding 1.85 but not exceeding 2m	Lm10.00
3.	Length overall including overhanging cargo exceeding 6.5m and not exceeding 7.5m, and/or width exceeding 2m but not exceeding 2.4m	Lm15.00
4.	Length overall including overhanging cargo exceeding 7.5m and not exceeding 8.5m and/or width exceeding 2.4m but not exceeding 2.5m	Lm23.00
5.	Length overall including overhanging cargo exceeding 8.5m and not exceeding 12m, and/or width exceeding 2.5m but not exceeding 2.8m	Lm29.00
6.	Length overall including overhanging cargo exceeding 12m and not exceeding 15m, and/or width exceeding 2.5m but not exceeding 2.8m	Lm38.00

7. Vehicles up to 4.7m length overall and not exceeding 1.7m in width fall under the car category
8. Surcharge for excess width over 2.8m after reaching maximum tariffs shall be Lm5.00 for every 10cm or part thereof.
9. Length in excess of 15m shall be charged at Lm5.00 per linear meter or part thereof.
10. Towed Trailer up to 5m shall pay Lm5.00. When length exceeds 5m payment shall be based on length overall of vehicle and towed trailer in accordance with the above tariffs.
11. A surcharge of Lm1.25 per linear meter will be applied for all vehicles falling under this schedule boarding from Sa Maison to Gozo or vice-versa.
