Speaker of the House of Representatives receives a group of students from the Faculty of Arts at the University of Malta

Speaker of the House of Representatives, Anġlu Farrugia, this afternoon received a courtesy visit by a group of students from the Faculty of Arts, Department of International Relations, University of Malta.

Addressing the students, the Speaker highlighted the importance which the Parliament of Malta gives to Parliamentary Diplomacy. He continued by saying that he led Parliamentary delegations on a number of official visits abroad, the participation of Members of Parliament in international fora such as the Parliamentary Assembly of the OSCE, the Council of Europe, the IPU and PAM.

The Speaker of the House of Representatives also mentioned the importance of the role of parliamentarians when they are requested to observe elections to assess whether the process meets internationally accepted criterias, concerning transparency above all.

The students led by Dr Valentina Cassar, Lecturer within the Department of International Relations, Faculty of Arts, made a number of questions to which Mr Speaker replied.
