Greek Ambassador pays farewell call on the Speaker of the House of Representatives

Ms Chryssoula Karykopoulou-Vlavianou, Ambassador of the Hellenic Republic of Greece, paid a farewell call on the Speaker of the House of Representative Anglu Farrugia.

Speaker Farrugia thanked the Greek Ambassador for all her efforts during her posting in Malta to enhance the very strong political bilateral relations existing between Malta and the Hellenic Republic of Greece.

The two dignitaries highlighted the fact that these ties have been reinforced by high level exchange visits and meetings, which include the two visits to Athens of Prime Minister Joseph Muscat and the visit to Malta of his Greek counterpart, Alexis Tsipras.

They discussed issues of mutual interest, particularly the enhancement of bilateral co-operation at Parliamentary level following the formation of Parliamentary Friendship Groups and the Maltese Diaspora, with the first known Maltese to settle in the Island of Corfu two hundred years ago.

Migration, Brexit, Libya, Syria, European Parliament elections, the forthcoming Greek legislative elections and other issues also featured in the discussion.
