Dear Honourable Muscat
I trust this email finds you well.

I act on behalf of Flimkien Ghal Ambjent Ahjar and Friends of the Earth Malta - the 2 ENGOS which have collectively submitted applications for 23 different sites to be designated as public domain sites in line with legislation enacted unanimously by the House of Representatives way back in 2016.

Nearly 3 years have passed since that our applications and despite reminders and meetings, not one single site has been designated as public domain.

You will recall that our last communication was in February 2018 when I had sent the email below.

You had cordially replied indicating that updates were still required from the Planning Authority and/or the Lands Authority.

In view of the fact that there are many threats being made to these pristine sites - and that the Planning Authority has ascertained that the Government owns the sites below, it is respectfully requested that the Environment Committee reconvene to discuss the state of play.
